

All Alberta Triple Crown Rules apply to Alberta Triple crown series

ABSOLUTELY NO PIT RIDING - See Ref and Marshall for designated areas

Advancement Committee – riders must have advancement committee approval before advancement, with the exception of pointing out.

All UTV rules apply to mini UTV classes. Refer to UTV rules.

There are classes offered in the ATC (Alberta Triple Crown) that are not offered in the ADRA Provincial Series or the AMSA Alberta Series. Mandatory rules apply to all series. A CMRC licence is required to participate.

Classes will not be run unless there is a minimum of 2 entries. The exception will be if the class can be safely combined with another class.

If a rider is under the Age of 18 a parental/minor consent form must be filled out and sign by Parent.

The Race Office Manager shall have the authority to penalize, disqualify and/or suspend any entrant or crewmember for the violation of these rules including special rulings.

The following safety requirements are mandatory for all ATVs:

- No pit riding
- Chest protectors on all 12 and under
- Boots – Closed toed boots are required, MX boots recommended
- Number plates on back of riders on either chest protector or on jersey, must have number plates on rear of bike. As well as front of bike.
- Tether cord that functions properly
- Nerf bars or OEM foot boards
- Number plates must be on machine – front, back, sides and you must have one on your back
- All classes are subject to random tech inspections throughout race day
- Open 4 x 4 classes must have all extras removed
- At all CMRC ATV sanctioned events; the rulings of the Referees/Promoters are final
- UTV classes must have extremity restraints- 4 OR 5 POINT HARNESS DOORS-NET OR SOLID
- UTV classes minimum requirement for neck brace is padded support collar
- UTV classes fire extinguisher mounted on machine
- UTVs must have a roof
- UTV drivers must use eye protection
- UTV drivers must use a 1 piece fire retardant suit or fire proof coveralls – NO MX gear

2) In all classes, the ATV's engine must not exceed class displacement limitations

3) All other CMRC rules apply (see 2016 CMRC rule book for details). All UVT classes must stay within displacement limits of the class. Production classes must use the approved OEM cylinder head, cylinder and cases, as well as OEM Frame. Engines cannot be stroked or bored in any production division. ATV Junior and Mini ATV are not limited to production rules, however they must fall within the displacement limits of the class.

4) ATV participants are permitted to compete in more than one class up to a maximum of 3 , provided they meet the rules and eligibility requirements for that class. In instances where a rider's machine becomes disabled prior to reaching the finish line AND he/she completed at least 50 percent of the total number of laps completed by the winner, he/she will receive last place points. In these circumstances, riders will NOT be required to physically push his/her machine

across the finish line. Riders who do physically push their machines across the finish line will be considered as having completed the race.

Mini ATV Beginner 0-110cc 2-Stroke, 0-125cc 4-Stroke

- Any production/modified production 4 wheeled ATV using OEM cylinder/bore/stroke within displacement limits
- 2 stroke or 4 stroke engines
- No increase over stock displacement
- red numbers on white backgrounds
- Maximum 14 years

Mini ATV Advanced 0-110cc 2-Stroke, 0-125cc 4-Stroke

- Any production/modified production 4 wheeled ATV
- 2 stroke or 4 stroke engines
- Bore, Stroke, Non-OEM engines/frames are permitted
- Bore and stroke may be altered but must remain within class displacement limits
- Maximum 14 years

Mini ATV Open 0-110cc 2-Stroke, 0-125cc 4-Stroke

- Any production/modified production 4 wheeled ATV
- 2 stroke or 4 stroke engines
- Bore, Stroke, Non-OEM engines/frames are permitted
- Bore and stroke may be altered but must remain within class displacement limits
- Maximum 14 years

Sportsman ATV 0-200cc 2-Stroke, 0-300CC 4-Stroke PRODUCTION CLASS

Note: Minis can ride in this class as long as they ride in the Mini advanced class as well

- Any production/modified production 4 wheeled ATV using OEM cylinder/ bore/stroke within displacement limits
- 2 stroke or 4 stroke engines
- No increase over stock displacement
- Black Numbers on white backgrounds,
- maximum 16 years of age as of Jan 1

Novice ATV 200cc to 400cc Production Class

-Any production/modified production 4 wheeled ATV using OEM cylinder/ bore/stroke within displacement limits, 2 stroke or 4 stroke engines

ATV Beginner Min 14 years 0-700cc

- Any production/modified production 4 wheeled ATV
- 2 stroke or 4 stroke engines
- Bore, Stroke, Non-OEM engines/frames are permitted
- Bore and stroke may be altered but must remain within class displacement limits
- Red numbers on white backgrounds

Beg/Jun GP Min 14 years 0-700cc

- Any production/modified production 4 wheeled ATV using OEM cylinder/ bore/stroke within displacement limits, 2 stroke or 4 stroke engines

ATV Junior Min 14 years 0-700cc

- Any production/modified production 4 wheeled ATV
- 2 stroke or 4 stroke engines
- Bore, Stroke, Non-OEM engines/frames are permitted
- Bore and stroke may be altered but must remain within class displacement limits
- Red numbers on white background

ATV Ladies B 0-450cc PRODUCTION CLASS

- Note: Can not ride in this class if you are junior and above
- Any production/modified production 4 wheeled ATV using OEM cylinder /bore/stroke within displacement limits
 - 2 stroke or 4 stroke engines
 - No increase over stock displacement

ATV Ladies A 0-450cc PRODUCTION CLASS

- Any production/modified production 4 wheeled ATV using OEM cylinder /bore/stroke within displacement limits
- 2 stroke or 4 stroke engines
- No increase over stock displacement

ATV Open Automatic Min 14 years 0-800cc PRODUCTION CLASS

- Any production/modified production 4 wheeled ATV using OEM cylinder /bore/stroke within displacement limits
- 2 stroke or 4 stroke engines
- No increase over stock displacement
- Stock transmission, no auto conversions
- Any 2 or 4WD spot or utility ATV
- Black numbers on white backgrounds

ATV Intermediate Min 14 years 0-450cc PRODUCTION CLASS

- Any production/modified production 4 wheeled ATV using OEM cylinder /bore/stroke within displacement limits.
- 2 stroke or 4 stroke engines
- No increase over stock displacement
- Black numbers on yellow backgrounds

ATV Veterans Min 35 years PRODUCTION CLASS

- Any production/modified production 4 wheeled ATV using OEM cylinder

/bore/stroke within displacement limits

-2 stroke or 4 stroke engines

-No increase over stock displacement

ATV Pro Min. 14 years 0-450cc PRODUCTION CLASS

-Any production/modified production 4 wheeled ATV using OEM cylinder

/bore/stroke within displacement limits

-2 stroke or 4 stroke engines

-No increase over stock displacement

-White numbers on blue backgrounds

ATV Pro Am Min. 14 years 0-450cc PRODUCTION CLASS

-Any production/modified production 4 wheeled ATV using OEM cylinder

/bore/stroke within displacement limits

-2 stroke or 4 stroke engines

-No increase over stock displacement

UTV Side X Side 200cc Max. Displacement age 8-15

-Any production/modified production 4 wheeled UTV using OEM cylinder

/bore/stroke within displacement limits

-2 stroke or 4 stroke engines

-No increase over stock displacement

-This class will not be combined with any other class

-Same rules apply as other UTV classes

-Red numbers on white background

UTV Beginner-Min. 16 years of age PRODUCTION CLASS

-Any production/modified production 4 wheeled UTV using OEM cylinder

/bore/stroke within displacement limits

-2 stroke or 4 stroke engines

-No increase over stock displacement

-Red numbers on white backgrounds

UTV OPEN- Min. 16 years of age Passenger and Driver PRODUCTION CLASS

-if classes are full they will be split into displacement sizes (see below)

-Riders must have a 4 or 5 point harness, and door webs or solid. All passengers must fill out a CMRC application along with the driver, passenger is to pay full entry

-Any production/modified production 4 wheeled UTV using OEM cylinder

/bore/stroke within displacement limits

-2 stroke or 4 stroke engines

-No increase over stock displacement

-Black numbers on white backgrounds
